Chapter 01

The 5 Tasks Every Business Should Automate First

You don't need to automate everything at once. Start with these five high-impact areas and you'll reclaim 10+ hours in your first week.

Why Start Here?

Most people try to automate everything at once and end up with a mess of half-working tools. The smarter approach is to pick your highest-volume, most repetitive tasks first. These five areas account for roughly 80% of the time most solopreneurs and small teams waste every week.

1 Email Triage & Responses

The average knowledge worker spends 2.5 hours a day on email. AI can draft replies, categorise incoming mail, and send routine responses automatically. Tools: Gmail + ChatGPT (via Zapier), or the Claude API with a simple webhook.

2 Social Media Scheduling & Content

Writing captions, resizing images, scheduling posts across platforms — all of this can be done by AI in minutes. Tools: Buffer + Claude for captions, Canva AI for visuals, n8n for multi-platform scheduling.

3 Content Creation & First Drafts

Blog posts, newsletters, product descriptions, ad copy — AI won't write the final version for you, but it can produce a solid first draft in under a minute. Tools: Claude, ChatGPT, Jasper. Pair with your Prompt Builder for best results.

4 Data Entry & Reporting

Moving data between spreadsheets, CRMs, and dashboards is pure time waste. Automate it with no-code tools. Tools: Zapier, n8n, Make (formerly Integromat), Google Sheets + AI formulas.

5 Customer FAQs & Support

If you answer the same 10 questions over and over, you need an AI-powered FAQ or chatbot. This alone can save 5+ hours a week for service businesses. Tools: Tidio, Crisp, or a custom ChatGPT assistant trained on your content.

Quick Win

Start with email. Set up a Gmail filter + ChatGPT Zapier integration this afternoon. It takes 30 minutes to configure and will save you 1-2 hours every single day.

You don't need to spend money to get started. Here are the best free tools in each category, tested and recommended for 2026.

Writing & Content

Claude (Anthropic)	FREE
<i>Writing & AI</i> — Best for long-form content, analysis, and nuanced writing. Free tier available.	
ChatGPT (OpenAI)	FREE
<i>Writing & AI</i> — Most versatile AI assistant. Free tier is powerful. GPT-4o included.	
Notion AI	FREE
<i>Writing & Docs</i> — Summarise, draft, and edit inside your workspace. Freemium.	

Automation & Workflows

n8n	FREE
<i>Automation</i> — Open-source, self-hostable workflow automation. More powerful than Zapier, free to self-host.	
Zapier (free tier)	FREE
<i>Automation</i> — 100 tasks/month free. Best for connecting popular apps without code.	
Make (Integromat)	FREE
<i>Automation</i> — 1,000 operations/month free. Visual workflow builder, great for complex flows.	

Image & Design

Canva AI	FREE
<i>Design</i> — Magic Design, text-to-image, background remover — all in the free plan.	
Adobe Firefly	FREE
<i>Image Generation</i> — Commercial-safe AI image generation. Free credits monthly.	
DALL-E 3 (via ChatGPT)	FREE
<i>Image Generation</i> — Included in ChatGPT free tier. Excellent for blog and social images.	

SEO & Research

Perplexity AI

FREE

Research — AI-powered search with citations. Far better than Google for research tasks.

AI Key For Riches Keyword Tool

FREE

SEO — Free keyword research tool. Find low-competition keywords for your niche.

Semrush (free tier)

FREE

SEO — 10 free searches/day. Enough to do basic keyword and competitor research.

Pro Tip: Stack Your Tools

The real power comes from connecting tools together. Use Claude to write content, Canva AI to create the image, then n8n to automatically post it to all your social channels. Three free tools, one automated workflow, zero manual work.

Chapter 03

Step-by-Step Workflow Templates You Can Copy

These are real workflows used by content creators and solopreneurs. Copy them, adapt them to your tools, and start saving time today.

Workflow A The Blog Post Factory

Write 4 blog posts a week in under 2 hours total.

1 Research

Use Perplexity AI to find your topic angles and gather facts. Ask: "What are the top 5 questions people ask about [topic] in 2026?"

2 Outline

Paste your research into Claude and ask for a structured H2/H3 outline with key points for each section.

3 Draft

Use ChatGPT or Claude to write each section from the outline. One section at a time = better quality.

4 Optimise

Run the draft through your keyword tool. Add the target keyword naturally to H1, first paragraph, and one H2.

5 Publish

Schedule via WordPress or your CMS. Use Canva AI to create a featured image in 2 minutes.

Workflow B The Social Media Engine

Turn one blog post into 7 days of social content automatically.

1 Extract

Paste your blog post into Claude and ask: "Extract 7 key insights from this post, each in one sentence."

2 Format

Ask Claude to rewrite each insight as a social post for LinkedIn, Twitter/X, and Instagram (different tone for each).

3 Visuals

For each post, ask Canva AI to generate a matching image using the key quote as the prompt.

4 Schedule

Upload all posts + images to Buffer or your social scheduler. Set to publish once per day.

5 Recycle

After 30 days, n8n can automatically re-queue your top-performing posts.

Workflow C The Email Response System

Handle your inbox in 20 minutes a day instead of 2 hours.

1 Filter

Set up Gmail filters to auto-label emails: Client, Lead, Newsletter, Admin. This sorts itself.

2 Templates

Build 10 AI prompt templates for your most common email types (quote request, follow-up, FAQ, etc).

3 Draft

For each email, paste it into Claude with your template prompt. Get a draft in 10 seconds. Edit in 30.

4 Automate FAQs

For truly repetitive questions, set up a Zapier zap: new email matching keyword -> send templated reply automatically.

5 Batch

Only check email twice a day — 9am and 3pm. AI handles the rest.

Chapter 04

How to Connect Tools with n8n & Zapier

You don't need to write a single line of code. Here's how to connect your AI tools into automated workflows using n8n and Zapier.

n8n vs Zapier — Which Should You Use?

Both tools let you connect apps and automate workflows visually. The key difference: Zapier is easier to set up but costs more at scale. n8n is free if you self-host it (on your VPS or a service like Railway), and far more powerful for complex workflows.

Your First n8n Workflow (Step by Step)

1 Install n8n

The fastest way is Railway.app (free tier). Sign up, create a new project, search for n8n in the template library, and deploy. Takes 5 minutes.

2 Connect your first app

In n8n, click "Add node" and search for Gmail. Authenticate with your Google account. Set the trigger to "New Email Received".

3 Add an AI node

Add an OpenAI or Claude node after Gmail. In the prompt field, write: "Summarise this email in 2 sentences and suggest a reply: {{\$json.body}}"

4 Route the output

Add a Gmail "Send Email" node. In the body field, use the AI output: {{\$json.message.content}}. Set recipient to the original sender.

5 Test & activate

Send yourself a test email. Check each node's output. When it works, click the toggle to activate the workflow. Done.

Recommended: Start with Zapier

If you've never used automation tools before, start with Zapier's free tier. It's more beginner-friendly. Once you hit the task limit or need more complex flows, migrate to n8n. You'll understand both tools much better by then.

Chapter 05

Measuring ROI: Know What's Actually Saving Time

You can't improve what you don't measure. Here's a simple framework to track the real value of your AI workflows.

The 3-Number Framework

To know if an automation is worth keeping, you need three numbers: time saved per week, your hourly rate, and setup/tool cost. Everything else is noise.

Time Saved

Track this for one week before automating, and one week after. Be honest — include setup time spread over 12 months. If a workflow takes 3 hours to build but saves 2 hours/week, it pays for itself in 1.5 weeks.

Your Effective Hourly Rate

If you charge \$50/hr for client work, every hour saved by AI = \$50 of value. If you use that time to create more content or close more deals, the ROI compounds. Use our free AI ROI Calculator at ai.keyforriches.com/ai-roi-calculator/ to run your numbers.

Tool Cost

Add up what you're paying for AI tools monthly. Divide by the hours saved. Most users find their effective cost is under \$5/hour of time saved — far cheaper than hiring help.

Chapter 06

Your 30-Day AI Automation Action Plan

Don't try to do everything at once. Follow this week-by-week plan and you'll have a fully running AI workflow system in 30 days.

Week 1 — Foundation

- Sign up for Claude and ChatGPT free tiers
- Identify your top 3 most repetitive tasks
- Set up your first email AI workflow (30 min)
- Use the Prompt Builder to create 5 saved prompts for your common tasks
- Track time spent on manual tasks this week (baseline)

Week 2 — Content Automation

- Set up Canva AI and generate your first AI-designed social images
- Create a content template in Claude for your main content type
- Write 3 pieces of content using AI drafts — time yourself
- Set up Buffer or another social scheduler
- Build the "Blog Post Factory" workflow from Chapter 3

Week 3 — Workflow Automation

- Sign up for Zapier free tier
- Connect Gmail + ChatGPT for email drafting (Zapier template)
- Set up automatic social media scheduling with n8n or Zapier
- Automate your most repetitive data task
- Test everything — fix what's broken

Week 4 — Measure & Optimise

- Fill in your tracking spreadsheet from Chapter 5
- Calculate your weekly hours saved and dollar value
- Identify which workflow saved the most time
- Double down: build one more automation in your top area
- Share your results and bookmark ai.keyforriches.com for weekly AI updates
